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

These easy, 4-ingredient Homemade Dog Treats are the perfect way to use up leftover Christmas turkey or chicken!

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup PLAIN mashed, cooked sweet potatoes
- 3/4 cup water
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- 2 cups finely chopped, cooked turkey or chicken
- 2 cups whole wheat flour or white whole wheat flour
- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F
- 2. Combine ingredients
- 3. Spread dough evenly onto a parchment-lined baking sheet
- 4. Use a knife or pizza cutter to score the dough into small rectangles
- 5. Bake for 30 minutes
- 6. Cool completely, then break along the score lines
- 7. Store in the refrigerator or freezer
